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The Madison Community Pool Corporation (Pool) is a separate membership organization that is a public charity and is not affiliated with the Borough of Madison. All members and guests must follow rules and staff instructions. Any misunderstandings or objections should be brought to the attention of the Pool Manager. The Manager has the authority to suspend membership when there is violation of Pool rules. Assistant Managers have full authority in Manager's absence. The priority goal of the management is to provide a safe and healthy environment for the members and their guests. Any changes to rules will be posted at the Pool.

Everyone using the Pool does so at his/her own risk. The Pool is not responsible for any accident, injury or loss of personal property. There are no checking facilities to secure belongings and/or valuables.

MEMBERS & GUESTS

- ❖ All Pool members **MUST** wear badges on swimsuits at all times. At the Pool entrance, Pool badges must be put on the bathing suit so it is visible. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS**. This is a safety issue. The badge is the means to identify individuals should an accident occur in the water.
- ❖ Once the Pool opens for the swimming season, there will be no refunds for membership fees.
- ❖ Badges are not transferable, even within a family. Anyone borrowing, loaning or passing a badge through the fence will cause the member to be suspended for two weeks.
- ❖ **NO BADGE = NO ENTRY** If you forget your badge and it is the first time, you will be allowed entry with a wristband and charged \$5. If you have forgotten your badge and it is not the first time, you will be asked to go home and get your badge. Lost badges can be replaced for a fee of \$5 for senior members and \$15 for individual or family members. Once a replacement badge has been issued there will be no refund.
- ❖ Members may purchase babysitter badges. Babysitters may use the Pool only when accompanying children with or without parents. Babysitters may only bring in guests of the children they supervise. Babysitters may not use the Pool for their own use, nor may they bring in their own guests.
- ❖ There will be a daily adult only swim for a period of 10 minutes occurring at 1 PM and 3 PM. Another may be called at the discretion of the manager.
- ❖ Members must register guests by filling out the guest information form, pay a guest fee, accompany their guest and take responsibility for the conduct of their guests while at the Pool. Guests **MUST** wear bracelets.
- ❖ Children under 13-years-old must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older who will be responsible for their conduct at the Pool. Children 10 to 12-years-old who have written

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parental approval on file with Manager and have passed the deep water test may come without an adult. This privilege may be suspended at the discretion of the Manager. Anyone dropping off a member under the age of 13 (with the exception of those members age 10-12 who have such written parental permission) and leaving them alone at the Pool will forfeit their membership without a refund.

- ❖ Non-swimming children may enter the 5 feet deep or less sections of the Pool when accompanied by a parent/guardian, conditions permitting. Non-Swimming Children are never permitted in the deep water tank, diving board, loop slide or drop slide. The Pool is not responsible for supervising your children within the Pool property – or in Memorial Park parking lots, picnic areas or playground.
- ❖ Non-swimming children may enter the 3 feet deep or less section if they are over the age of 5 conditions permitting. The Pool is not responsible for supervising your children within The Pool property.
- ❖ Pre-Teen parties are for children 10-12 with an orange badge and their guests who have passed the deep water test. Signed parental permission forms, either already on file or completed for the party, are required to gain admission to the party. There is a small fee for the party.
- ❖ **The Pool prohibits the use of flotation devices (defined as anything device that can keep a person afloat including but not limited to: swim vests, life vests, swimmies, arm floats, rafts, noodles) in the Main and wading pools except during Moonlight swims, Pre-teen parties and special events. Those using the adult lap lanes are allowed to use swim training equipment. Water guns are not permitted.**
- ❖ Any guest under the age of 13 years must be accompanied by a member 18 years or older.
- ❖ Any guest over the age of 13 years old may be accompanied by a member aged 13 thru 18, if a parent of the guest or member signs a permission form.
- ❖ Any guest over the age of 18 may be able to stay without the member present, provided a guest form is signed by the sponsoring member.
- ❖ Guests that are part of a party must be met at the front desk by an adult member, unless a list of attendees is given to the Pool management prior to the party and payment has been made.
- ❖ Guest privileges are extended to Madison residents on **weekdays only**. Madison residents over the age of 14 are not permitted as guests on Saturday or Sunday, except for Moonlight Swims or special events. The Manager may suspend guest privileges if necessary to relieve overcrowding.
- ❖ Guests are subject to the same rules and regulations as members. Violation of rules and regulations may result in the loss of guest privileges for the member and/or the guests.

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OUR SMALLEST SWIMMERS

- ❖ The Wading pool is for children 5-years-old and younger, **under constant adult supervision**.
- ❖ Children using the wading pool must wear swimming diapers or diapers that are covered with plastic panties.
- ❖ All children must be toilet trained to use any section of the Main Pool. **Absolutely NO DIAPERS or swimmies** are permitted in the Main Pool. NO EXCEPTIONS. Members caught violating this rule more than twice in a season will have their membership privileges suspended for two weeks.

DEEP WATER TEST

- ❖ The Deep Water Test is given at 1:00 pm, 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm daily. **A child may take the test two times a day.** The sign up for the Deep Water Test is maintained at the Front Desk.
- ❖ The managers of the Pool have the discretion of determining the rules for the deep water test. A copy of the current rules are maintained at the front desk.

ADULT LAP LANES PROTOCOL

- ❖ Do not enter an occupied lane without letting the swimmer(s) already in the lap lane that you are entering. Get their attention by dangling your legs into the water or standing to the side at the end of the lane. Discuss with each swimmer how you will share the lane.
- ❖ Do not enter an occupied lane if another is empty.
- ❖ If there are two swimmers in the lane, it can be split into halves and each swimmer swims in one half of the lane.
- ❖ If there are more than two swimmers in the lane, they must all circle counterclockwise in the lane. Always swim on the right side of the lane when circle swimming. This means swimming on one side of the lane going down and the other side of the lane coming back.
- ❖ Only if you are alone in a lane, can you swim following the middle line.
- ❖ Don't push off the wall right in front of a faster swimmer. Let him/her pass first. The fastest swimmer has the right of way; slower swimmers must yield. Likewise, don't push off right behind a slower swimmer. Leave some room for the other slower swimmer before pushing off.

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- ❖ Pass on the left hand side. If you are the slower swimmer and being overtaken at the turn, stop, and wait until the other swimmer has pushed off the wall.
- ❖ A pass must be initiated in time to over-take the slower swimmer before the wall. A pass may be initiated only if there is no risk of collision with a swimmer on the other side of the lane.
- ❖ Lap lanes are for swimming complete laps, not for water aerobics, water walking or socializing. If you need to rest, do it at the wall and stay as far to the side as possible, leaving room for other swimmers to turn.
- ❖ Swim training equipment (kick board, pull-buoy, flippers, etc.) is permitted in the lap lanes.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- ❖ NO SMOKING is permitted within the confines of the Pool.
- ❖ No Spitting is allowed in the Pool facilities.
- ❖ No one is allowed in water without lifeguards on duty. Members must refrain from conversations with lifeguards on duty. The Manager may announce periodic rest periods for lifeguards and clear Pool completely.
- ❖ The manager may announce periodic adult swims for members 18 years old and older. The 3 foot section of the Pool will remain open to children with Red badges only.
- ❖ There will be **no diving** anywhere in the Pool except off of the diving board in the diving tank. The only exception to this will be during swim lessons, team practices, and swim meets.
- ❖ There will be **no jumping** into the Pool except in five (5) foot marked areas and off the diving board.
- ❖ There will be no prolonged holding of breath underwater as a test of endurance. This is a dangerous action and can result in death or serious injury.
- ❖ There will be no diving or jumping off the steps or ladders into the Pool.
- ❖ There will be no sitting on the steps of the Pool as that blocks entry or exits.
- ❖ The deep water tank is for diving and slide exits only. One person is permitted on the diving board and each slide at a time. Approved sports are restricted to designated areas.
- ❖ No water paraphernalia is allowed in main Pool including balls, rings or diving darts except when used by swimming instructors and for use in the pool basketball game. Throwing and diving for stones or other objects is prohibited.

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- ❖ Running, pushing, towel snapping, profane language or other behavior creating danger or annoyance is prohibited in all areas of the Pool's Facilities.
- ❖ Benches surrounding the Pool should not be moved.
- ❖ Chairs and towels should not be placed on the concrete decking surrounding the Pool.
- ❖ Swimmers with skin lesions, inflamed eyes or discharge from nose or ears, open blisters or cuts are not permitted in water. Bandages are not allowed in water.
- ❖ All injuries at the Pool must be reported immediately to Manager.
- ❖ No Animals other than Seeing Eye or Registered Service Dogs are permitted on premises.
- ❖ The Slide in three (3) foot area is restricted to use by children 3-9 years of age only.
- ❖ No age restriction on the slide into the 3 ½ foot water. Badge restrictions will apply on this slide.

PARKING

- ❖ Parking is allowed in the parking lots only. **NO PARKING IS ALLOWED ON THE GRASS AT ANY TIME.** There are three parking lots available. Lot #1 on the left, Lot #2 on the right and Lot #3 the upper lot on Rosedale Ave.
- ❖ Members will be allowed to drop off at the circle in front of the entrance of the Pool. There is no parking allowed in the circle. Waiting time is limited to 15 minutes.

REFRESHMENTS

- ❖ Members and Guests are encouraged to order food from the snack bar on site. Ordering food from outside vendors and consuming that food inside the Pool area will not be allowed.
- ❖ Members and Guests may bring small snacks to the Pool and eat them on the grassy area.
- ❖ Members and Guests are responsible for cleaning up any trash resulting from food they have brought in to the Pool.
- ❖ The fenced snack area at the far end of the Pool may be reserved for parties for a fee of \$25. Members are asked to ensure their party guests consume food within the confines of the fence.

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- ❖ Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on premises. Soft drinks may be brought to the Pool if stored in plastic containers. **Glass is not permitted on premises.**

- ❖ Members may leave their own collapsible outdoor lawn or beach chairs in a storage rack at the Pool.
- ❖ Members leave chairs at their own risk and must provide their own lock and chain if desired.
- ❖ There is no charge for storage, but there is a limit of one chair per member.
- ❖ Guests are not permitted to store chairs at the Pool.
- ❖ Any chairs left at the Pool at the end of the season will be disposed.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 – Membership

Any person over the age of fifteen (15) years shall be eligible for membership in the corporation. Individuals between fifteen (15) and eighteen (18) years of age need parental consent. The Board of Trustees shall be the final arbiters of the bona fides of residence.

Section 2 – Classes of Membership

There shall be three (3) membership categories: Madison Resident, Non-Madison Resident (NMR) and Masters. Within the Madison Resident and NMR categories, there shall be **family**, **individual**, and **senior** levels, described as follows:

A. I. A **family** membership shall be defined as:

- (1) A husband and/or wife and/or domestic partner, and all children residing in the same household who are under the age of twenty-six (26) and fully dependent on the head of household for their support and maintenance.
- (2) Unmarried family members who are serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.
- (3) Parents of either or both the husband and/or wife who reside with and are dependent for support, upon either the husband and/or wife.
- (4) A Fresh Air Fund child or other charitable ward residing with the family.
- (5) Unmarried family members over the age of twenty-six (26) years who are considered physically and/or mentally challenged in that they are unable to pursue gainful employment sufficient to allow them to support themselves and who therefore remain fully dependent on the head of the household for their support and maintenance.

II. A **family** membership does not include:

- (1) Siblings, cousins, or nieces and nephews of the adult members, regardless of residency
- (2) Visiting relatives, regardless of length of stay
- (3) A divorced spouse
- (4) For convenience, any of the above can be added to a family membership as a “babysitter” for the posted fee

B. An **individual** membership shall be defined as any individual as defined in Section 1 of the Article and not included in the definition of family above. Individual memberships are not allowed to bring other household members as their guests.

C. A **senior** membership shall be defined as an individual person sixty-two (62) years of age or older.

D. A **babysitter** membership shall be defined as a subset of the **family** membership. A babysitter (employee of the family, nanny, au pair, etc.) must be fifteen (15) years of age or older, and have as their primary duty the care and supervision of dependent children who are part of a **family** membership. If the babysitter’s duties are such that their presence at the pool is required in order to allow them to carry out their duties, they shall be permitted to use the pool in accordance with the Rules and/or Regulations promulgated by the Board of Trustees. Additionally, others who do not meet the definition of family member included in section 2 A. II may be added to the family membership as a babysitter.

E. Non-Madison Resident (NMR) membership shall be defined as follows:

- (1) There shall be the same three (3) levels of membership for NMR - **family**, **individual**, and **senior** - using the same definitions, except as regarding residency, as outlined in Section 2 sub-paragraphs A, B and C. However, NMR family memberships shall be limited.
- (2) Membership fees for NMR members will be at a premium, higher than fees charged to Madison residents.
- (3) NMR memberships are open to all non-residents on a first-come first-served basis. Previous year’s NMR memberships shall automatically renew if payment is received by April 15th of the current year. If payment is not received by April 15th, the membership application shall be handled on a first-come first-served basis with first time NMR applicants.
- (4) The number of NMR memberships shall be reviewed by the Board of Trustees annually to insure Madison residents have priority regarding becoming members.
- (5) NMR memberships shall carry with them no voting rights in the Corporation.
- (6) NMR members shall have all other rights of membership and shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Corporation.
- (7) NMR individual memberships are not allowed to bring other household members as their guests.

- F. A Masters Membership shall be defined as any individual as defined in Section 1 of this Article III, who is a current member of United States Masters Swimming, Inc. Masters members shall be permitted use of the pool for early morning lap swim only. Masters members are not issued badges and are not permitted to bring guests.

Section 3 – Membership Applications

- A. All applications for membership shall be in writing, addressed to the Corporation, and shall be accompanied by the payment of the annual dues and capital assessment fee, if applicable, for the year in which application is made. Non-dependent members of the same household over the age of 26 may join upon payment of annual dues equivalent to those for an individual membership and will not be subject to a capital assessment.
- B. Madison residents shall have preference over non-Madison residents should it become necessary to limit membership for purposes of pool safety. Further, previous year's resident members shall have preference over new applicants, if limitation of membership becomes necessary for purposes of pool safety.

Section 4 – Membership Voting Privileges

Madison resident members joining under an individual or a senior membership shall be eligible to vote and to serve on the Board of Trustees of the Corporation, with the exception of those individuals under the age of eighteen (18). Either the husband or the wife and/or domestic partner of a family joining under a Madison resident family membership shall be eligible to serve on the Board of Trustees of the Corporation. However, both the husband and wife or domestic partner shall be eligible to vote as members of the Corporation. Voting privileges shall be denied in the event that the annual dues have not been paid.

Section 5 – Membership Privilege for Guests

Members shall be privileged to bring guests to the pool facility in accordance with Rules and/or Regulations pertaining thereto and in force as promulgated by the Board of Trustees.

Section 6 – Membership Privileges

The membership privileges of any member defined in Section 2 may be suspended or revoked in accordance with the provisions of Section 7 of this Article III.

Section 7 – Membership Suspension and Revocation

- A. Membership for any member as defined in Section 2 may be suspended or revoked for a good cause shown for a period of no more than one year, after notice and hearing as provided in sub-paragraph C below. However, the Pool Manager shall have the authority to suspend the membership privileges of any individual, family or member of any family for a period not to exceed two (2) weeks without prior notice or hearing for conduct of that individual, family or member of any family contrary to the Rules and/or Regulations promulgated by the Board of Trustees and in force for the government of the Corporation and its members.
- B. Cause for suspension or revocation of membership privileges may be any one or more of the following:
- (1) Non-payment of dues.
 - (2) Conduct prejudicial to the interest of the Corporation.
 - (3) Conduct constituting violation of these By-Laws or the Rules and/or Regulations promulgated by the Board of Trustees and in force for the government of the Corporation and its members.
- C. When a complaint or series of complaints has or have been made against a person exercising membership privileges, and either the Board of Trustees or the Pool Manager is of the opinion that the alleged offense or alleged offenses is or are of such a nature as to require action by a quorum of the Board of Trustees, then the matter shall be referred to the Board of Trustees and a written notice embodying the complaint or complaints shall be served upon such person. A date shall be set for a hearing not less than three (3) days following the service of such notice. At the hearing, the person charged shall be given full opportunity to be heard and to present such matters as shall go to the defense or mitigation of the charges. Following the presentation of all such evidence, the quorum of the Board of Trustees shall vote on the question or suspension or revocation of membership privileges. Suspension of membership privileges for a period not to exceed one (1) month shall be imposed by a majority vote of the quorum of the Board of Trustees. Suspension of membership privileges for a period in excess of one (1) month or full revocation of membership privileges shall be authorized by an affirmative two-thirds (2/3) vote of the quorum of the Board of Trustees.

Section 8 – Membership Nontransferable

Membership shall not be transferable.

LESSONS LEVEL DESCRIPTION (follows the Red Cross six-level Learn-to-Swim program)

1	Introduction to Water Skills: Teaches familiarity with water, bobbing, retrieving submerged objects and water safety. Introduces floating, glides, and alternating arm and leg action on front and back.
2	Fundamental Aquatic Skills: Teaches full submersion, floats, glides, and treading water. Combines alternating arm and leg action for Front Crawl and Backstroke.
3	Stroke Development: Teaches diving, rotary breathing, treading water, Front Crawl and Backstroke. Introduces streamline position, the Butterfly kick, and Elementary Backstroke. Proficiency at this skill level prepares the swimmer to pass the Deep Water Test. Exit assessment: Pass Deep Water Test.
4	Stroke Improvement: Introduces Breaststroke, Sidestroke, Butterfly, open turns, and surface diving. Exit assessment: swim 2 lengths of the pool without resting.
5	Stroke Refinement: Introduces shallow angle dive, sculling, and treading water for 5 minutes. Focuses on increasing swim distances. Exit assessment: swim 4 lengths of the pool without resting.
6	Skill Proficiency: Teaches advanced turns and long-distance swimming. Refines all skills and strokes. Exit assessment: swim 20 lengths of the pool without resting. (Session 1 and 2 Only)
